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FIRST PART-GENERAL PROVISIONS

Art. 1 - Name, class of affiliation, headquarters and period

1. The inter-university, international, multilingual master's degree program in European Languages, Cultures and Societies in contact is enabled by the University of Pavia (by the Department of Humanities connected with the Departments of: Political and Social Sciences, Industrial Engineering and Information, Mathematics) jointly with six European Universities (University of Coimbra, University of Iași, University of Jena, University of Poitiers, University of Salamanca, University of Turku), components of the EC2U Alliance (EC2U Alliance) within the project European Campus of City-Universities (EC2U, Grant Agreement n.101004065-EC2U), core project of the European Union within the EPLUS2020-AG action of the EPP-EUR-Topic UNIV-2020 of the ERASMUS + program, coordinated by University of Poitiers, to encourage university education in Europe with the establishment of European macro-campus of seven consortium universities.
2. The master's degree course belongs to the LM-38 class of master's degrees in modern languages for communication and international cooperation as per the DM n. 1649 of 19th December 2023.
3. Master degree course period is two years and includes from a minimum of two to a maximum of four six-month mobility of the student and student must stay in the same University for a maximum of two semesters.

Art. 2 - Reference regulatory texts.

Students, who choose to attend the international master's degree course, the Supplement convention no. 5 to EC2U Consortium Agreement Establishment of Master Program (available at https://studiumanistici.unipv.it/?pagina=p&titolo=Laurea_magistrale_internazionale_EC2U e https://ec2u.eu/for-students/ec2u-master-programmes/european-languages-cultures-and-societies-in-contact/?sf_s=SUPPLEMENT) defined by all the universities of the EC2U Alliance.

For anything not expressly furnished in the Agreement, the Regulations of the University by the student attended apply for each semester as detailed in art. 7.

Particularly, students who choose to attend one or two semesters at the University of Pavia, in addition to the provisions incorporated in these Regulations: the Statute of the University of Pavia, the General Regulations of the University (viewable on the page: <https://portale.unipv.it/it/ateneo/organizzazione/statuto-e-regolamenti>), the University Didactic Regulations, the Student Career Regulations (viewable on the page: <https://portale.unipv.it/it/ateneo/organizzazione/statuto-e-regolamenti> « Didactic Regulation »), the Regulations of the Department of Humanities (viewable at the page <https://studiumanistici.dip.unipv.it/it/dipartimento/atti-e-documenti>).

Art. 3 - Institution accountable for teaching and organizational coordination

The international inter-university degree programme has the following organizational structure:

- **The Global Academic Board**, it consists of the contact persons of the seven partner universities of the Master's Degree European Languages, Cultures and Societies in contact, that discipline and supervises the teaching activities and the quality of the study course at European level.
- **The Supranational Quality Assurance Board** is accountable for the total assessment and monitoring of the standards of the Master's degree course and guarantees quality assurance at a global level. It is made up of representatives of the Quality Assurance Management Groups of the individual partner universities, in order to optimize and harmonize the monitoring and possible revision of the study course.
- **The Local Quality Assurance Boards /Local Management Groups for the Quality Assurance of the course of study**, where planned by the Local Quality Assurance System. As regards the University of Pavia, the Local Quality Assurance Management Group will be organized of at least two lecturers + one student representative, with the

following tasks: periodic monitoring of the quality of the study course, through the analysis of the indicators provided by the University and the Ministry and in addition, the evaluations of teaching expressed by the students through the compilation of questionnaires; possible revision of the course of study in consonance with the partners if the situation requires it; persistent attention to any problems that may the student component can arise.

➤ **Admission Committee** at supranational level: it guarantees the admission process for students in accordance with the provisions of the admission notice. The Admission Committee is composed of at least one representative from each consortium university. In compliance with the competences and criteria defined by the Regulations indicated in art. 2, the collegiate institution that, at University level, formally has the didactic responsibility at local level of the course of studies, and will take the possible decisions according to the indications provided by the Local Management Group for QA and the Global Academic Board is the Council of the Department of Humanities. The University also has the WELCOME OFFICE as a reception point for students. Future freshmen, enrolled students and graduate students are provided with information relating to the educational offer, student career, teaching activities, the right to study, and guidance.

Part Two - Organization of didactic activities

Art. 5 - Single Yearly Form of the Degree Course

Art. 6 - Admission requirements

1. To be admitted to the Master's Degree course, the student must have a degree (including the one completed congruently with the system prior to Ministerial Decree 509/1999 and subsequent amendments and additions) or a three-year university degree, or other qualification. studies completed abroad, released by a higher education institution that belongs to a member state of the European Higher Education Area that gives the right to access the Master's Degree courses in a certain partner country. Graduates from educational systems outside the European Higher Education Area may also be admitted if they have an analogous university qualification.

2. To be admitted, the student must have curricular requirements and the adequacy of the student's initial preparation are also required. The curricular requirements are the three-year degree completed in the classes: L-1; L-3; L-5; L-6; L-10, L-11; L-12; L-14; L-15; L-16, L-19, L-20, L-24, L-33, L-36, L-37, L-39, L-40, L-41, L-42, L-43, LMG-1 (ex DM 270/04) and in the corresponding classes ex DM 509/99 and previous regulations. For candidates with a first level qualification completed in universities abroad, the curricular requirements will be evaluated on the basis of the educational content of the origin degree program Concerning the initial preparation, it is necessary to have an adequate basic culture in one or more fields regarding the Humanities and Social Sciences (SSH) (an example of that: linguistics, literature, culture, history, society, international relations) .

3. Additionally, It is required to have certified C1 level of at least two of the following languages (including mother tongue) : Spanish, German, French, Italian, Portuguese, Romanian, Finnish and English (simply to attend the semester at the University of Turku) . It is necessary to have an adequate level of understanding English as a lingua franca. The Commission reserves the right to conduct appropriate assessments during the interviews, in order to confirm or waive the requirement of a language certification for candidates who are able to demonstrate proficiency at the required level, despite holding a lower-level certification. The Commission reserves also the right to exempt students graduated in Italy in degree classes L-11 “Modern Languages” and Cultures and L-12 “Linguistic Mediation” from presenting the certification for the languages included in their Transcript of Records.

4. Admission involves a selection whose contents and methods are defined in the specific admission notice, that will be promoted on the EC2U website (<https://ec2u.eu/>), at the page: <https://portale.unipv.it/it/didattica/corsi-di-laurea/corsi-di-laurea-magistrale/european-languages-cultures-and-societies-contact> _ or <https://europeancultures.cdl.unipv.it/en> and on the website of each University of the Consortium in the following languages: English, Finnish, French, German, Italian, Portuguese, Romanian, Spanish.

5. The Admission Committee will examine the applications on the basis of the documentation produced and, following the criteria specified in the announcement, will formulate a ranking in order to cover the number of places.

6. Admitted students enroll at the University where they decide to accomplish the first semester according to the regulations of that University. Students will also be automatically enrolled in other universities where they spend a semester of study based on the study plan proposed (University of the Second Semester, University of the Third Semester and University of the Fourth Semester). Enrollment must comply with the national legal requirements for the release of Multiple Master's Degrees.

Art. 7 - Didactic organization

1. The courses in the study plan are proportionate with ECTS credits (or CFU), that express the volume of learning, based on learning outcomes and the related workload. 60 ECTS / CFU credits are attributed to the learning outcomes and related workload of a full-time academic year Stessa parte. The seven Universities of the Alliance proposed courses that are 5 or 10 ECTS-ECTS established on the training proposal provided by the single University.

2. The training course jointly formulated by the seven EC2U partner universities includes 120 CFU / ECTS distributed into **30 CFU / ECTS per semester**, for a total of four semesters. Each semester includes: a compulsory teaching of 10 CFU / ECTS of a methodological nature, delivered online by all the Universities of the EC2U Alliance and 20 CFU / ECTS of teaching in presence, at each of the partner universities, organized around two macro-areas: European Modern Languages and Linguistics (for 10 CFU / ECTS) and European Modern Literatures, Cultures and Societies (for 10 CFU / ECTS). In the first and second semester, each University offers from 2 to 4 courses for each of these two macro-areas, among which, the student can choose to reach the required 10 CFU / ECTS. In the third semester, on the other hand, the student can freely choose 10 CFU / ECTS from the set of courses proposed globally by the numerous Universities for the European Modern Literatures, Cultures and Societies Area, while for the European Modern Languages and Linguistics Area the student completes 10 CFU / ECTS in courses that develop additional linguistic knowledge / computer skills. The fourth semester is dedicated to the research and the drafting of the degree thesis, that takes place under the co-supervision of teachers of the EC2U consortium. Students' thesis will be formulated and will be written in a university of their choice.

10 CFU/ECTS Research Methodology in European Modern Languages and Literatures (online, common to all universities, compulsory)

10 CFU/ECTS European Modern Literatures, Cultures and Societies (obligatory course)

10 CFU/ECTS European Modern Languages and Linguistic (obligatory course)

• Semester 3

10 CFU/ECTS Research Methodology in European Cultures and Societies (online, common to all universities, compulsory)

10 CFU/ECTS European Modern Languages and Linguistics (free choice courses)

10 CFU/ECTS European Modern Literatures, Cultures and Societies (free choice courses)

• Semester 4

30 CFU/ECTS Research and co-writing thesis

4. The student chooses the University where they plan to spend each of the four semesters of the training course, ensuring **at least two semester abroad** and with the condition of being able to study only a maximum of two semesters in the same University. Student mobility will be jointly supervised by the Consortium institutions through the EC2U interchange platform designated by Work Package 3 of the Project, that connects the local mobility management systems of the Alliance Universities.

5. The Degree Course is multilingual, so, the courses will be in different languages, mainly in the mother tongue spoken in the country of the Consortium Institutions chosen by the student (Finnish, French, German, Italian, Portuguese, Romanian and Spanish) and/or in English.

6. The didactic organization of the courses (teaching calendar, class periods and times, exam sessions, etc.) may change in detail in accordance with the university that it offers them. Each university will divulge the pertinent information on the following web pages:

Art. 8 - Study plans

1. The study plan includes the entire academic path the student intends to follow (University of the first semester, University of the second semester, University of the third semester and University of the fourth semester).
2. The standard study plan is the set of educational activities (obligatory, optional, and free- choice), with any preparatory qualifications, that the student is required to follow in order to obtain the multiple degree (from a minimum of two to a maximum of four qualifications depending on mobility). The standard study plan of the inter-university international master's degree course is represented by the training activities provided for the cohort of students (**see Annex 1**).
3. The student, who intends to follow a training path other than that provided for in the standard study plan, may submit an individual study plan, which must in any case comply with the rules and restrictions on mobility set out in art. 7.
4. The individual study plan, which provides for a number of CFU / ECTS not less than that required for the achievement of the multiple degree, is valid and can be approved if it complies with the regulations and regulations of the universities of the Alliance. As far as the University of Pavia is concerned, the constraints established by the class of the degree program and by the Regulations of the academic year of enrolment will apply.

Art. 9 - Achievement of multiple title

1. The student, who completes with success the course of study, will receive a Master's Degree in European Languages, Cultures and Societies in Contact from each of the Universities of the EC2U Alliance where he has acquired at least 30 CFU / ECTS and he has complied with the national minimum academic requirements. On the condition that the course of study has obtained the national accreditation and will be registered according to national / local regulations the Diploma will be released. The student receives 2, 3 or 4 Diplomas, depending on the number of universities where he has achieved the minimum national academic requirements.
2. Moreover, the multilateral diplomas, each student will receive a joint certificate from the EC2U European Universities Alliance that shows the graduate name and the logos of all the partner institutions of the Consortium, and a Transcript of records (ToR) that lists the courses that the student has attended, the exams passed and the credits acquired by the student. The student will receive the Diploma Supplement that illustrates the details of the student's academic program and academic achievements adapted to a common assessment system following the prototype prepared by the European Commission, the Council of Europe and UNESCO / CEPES and adapted to any further specification in national law, where applicable too.

Art. 10 - Attendance and preparatory obligations

1. With the exception referred to in the next paragraph, there are no special procedures for controlling the frequency that is recommended in any case.
2. There are no prerequisites. Any prerequisites will be indicated in the course programs (provided both by the University of Pavia and by the other Universities of the Alliance) available on the website <https://unipv.coursecatalogue.cineca.it/> o <https://studiumanistici.dip.unipv.it/it/didattica/corsi-di-laurea>

Art. 11 - Activities that are chosen by the student voluntarily.

1. The study plan provides for the insertion of 10 CFU / ECTS of free choice in the third semester (referred to in Article 10, paragraph 5.a, Ministerial Decree 270/2004 - so-called "TAF D"). Students will be able to freely choose from the set of courses offered globally by the various universities for the European Modern Literatures, Cultures and Societies Area, indicated in the study plan.
2. It is allowed to add, for each year, additional training activities for a maximum of 24 ECTS.

Art. 12 - Internship and training

Through the presentation of an individual study plan, the student will be able to carry out an internship period in agencies, companies or public or private organizations, affiliated, operating at local, national or international level, in the field of culture, cultural and linguistic mediation, cultural diplomacy, traditional and digital communication, automatic text processing applied to linguistic, cultural and social research. This internship may allow the acquisition of 10 ECTS / CFU. The student who has acquired the internship ECTS / CFU will be able to prepare a professional-oriented degree dissertation, linked to the internship period carried out and will also be able to make use of the supervision of the internship tutor as well as university tutors.

Art. 13 - Exams and final assessments of profit

1. All courses are weighted according to the ECTS / CFU system and in compliance with national regulations. In light of the inter-university and international nature of the course of study, the Partner Universities accept the differences between national regulations regarding the allocation of ECTS credits and recognize the number of ECTS credits awarded by the Alliance Universities for the course of study without further conversion.
2. The completion of the exams takes place on the basis of the regulations in force at the University of the Alliance that provides the teaching. Each partner University assigns marks based on its own evaluation system.
3. The evaluation methods and criteria, the grade, the grade conversion table, access to information on grades, replies and revaluations, incorrect practices and fraud are managed by each partner University according to common rules and in compliance with local legislation. 4. The exams can be held in written and / or oral form, in the manner that the teacher deems most suitable for verifying learning. The choice of asking students to present oral papers previously prepared on topics agreed with the teacher will be privileged.

5. For each course, an information sheet has been created that contains all the information relating to the number of hours of teaching activity, the number of CFU / ECTS, the timing, the contents, the bibliography, and the learning assessment method. This information will be published on the web page dedicated to the master's degree on the EC2U European Alliance portal (<http://www.ec2u.eu>) and on the websites of the various consortium universities, which for the University of Pavia are: the website of the Master's Degree in European Languages, Cultures, Societies in Contact: <https://europeancultures.cdl.unipv.it/en> and the General Catalog of University courses: : <https://unipv.coursecatalogue.cineca.it/cerca-insegnamenti>

Art. 14 - Final exam and achievement of the multiple degree

1. The multiple degree is awarded after passing a final test, which will aim to verify the achievement of the educational objectives of the master's degree course.
2. The final exam is accessed after having acquired at least 90 CFU / ECTS; it provides for the acquisition of another 30 CFU / ECTS. The thesis work consists in the accurate and rigorous elaboration by the student of an original written dissertation aimed at achieving advanced results in the research field, both for the topic assigned and for the working methods applied. The topic of the thesis must be consistent with the two-year course of study. The thesis will be carried out in co-tutorship under the supervision of at least two professors who belong to two different partner universities.
3. The maximum score is 110 points (with the committee being able to award up to 8 points). The possible granting of honours, beyond the maximum score, is subject to the unanimous approval of the Graduation Committee.
4. Through the presentation of a personal study plan, the student can choose among a research thesis and a professional-oriented dissertation, correlated to an internship period conducted in public or private agencies or organizations, affiliated, that act at local or national level or international, in the area of culture, cultural and linguistic mediation, cultural diplomacy, traditional and digital communication, automatic text processing pertained to linguistic, cultural and social research. The student, in this circumstance, will formulate the thesis in co-tutorship under the supervision of at least two professors who belong to two different partner universities and he may also benefit himself of the internship tutor supervision. In this circumstance the thesis will permit 20 CFU / ECTS (as 10 CFU / ECTS will be acquired through the internship).
5. The degree thesis will be formulated during the fourth semester and will be evaluated in the way prescribed by the regulations and regulations of the partner university that it has been chosen for the fourth semester (the regulations can be consulted at the links indicated in art. 13).

Part Three - Provisions relating to student career

Art. 15 - Criteria for the recognition of duly certified extra-university knowledge and skills

According to art. 3 of DM n. 931 of 4 July 2024, the Department Council (with its own resolution subject to the opinion of the referring professor and at the request of the student) may recognize up to a maximum of 24 ECTS credits within the two-year programme (subject to a total limit of 48 ECTS credits over the entire academic career), for the following:

- a) professional knowledge and skills certified in accordance with current legislation, as well as other knowledge and skills acquired through post-secondary level training activities;
- b) training activities undertaken within study programmes at public administration training institutes, as well as other knowledge and skills developed in post-secondary level training activities that a University has taken part in the design and implementation;
- c) the achievement by the student of an Olympic or Paralympic medal, or the title of absolute world champion, absolute European champion, or absolute Italian champion in disciplines recognized by the Italian National Olympic Committee (CONI) or the Italian Paralympic Committee (CIP).

The recognition must be made exclusively on the basis of the skills demonstrated by each student, so the Department Council will examine from time to time the possible opportunity to make a consultation with the

students to verify, in front of a specific commission, the congruence between the credits of which need validation and the knowledge and skills that they actually have.

With regard to the recognition mentioned in point c), the Department Council can validate, for a maximum of 12 credits, the performance of sports activities certified by the competent authorities, in the following terms:

- Sport practiced at Olympic and Paralympic, world and European level: up to 6 CFU;
- Sport practiced at Italian level and intermediate categories: up to 3 CFU;
- Qualification in the "medal zone" at the University Championship, so the performance of competitive activities for the sections of the CUS Pavia, in the context of competitions at regional and national level too: up to 6 CFU. It is granted to High-level student-athletes the opportunity to agree with the teachers ad hoc appeals in the episode of concurrent sporting commitments (competitions, training and related travel).

Art. 16 - Criteria for the recognition of the credits acquired

1. The Department Council decides on the recognition of the credits acquired: upon request submitted by the student (in accordance with the procedures and times provided for in the regulations in force) and after analyzing the associated documentation.

- a) in the circumstance of enrollment in single courses
- b) in the circumstance of transfer from another university, transition from another study course or performance of parts of educational activities in another Italian or foreign university
- c) in the circumstance of transfer or passage of the student among study courses of the same class
- d) in the circumstance of a transfer or passage of the student between courses of study in the same class (in this circumstance, the amount of credits relating to the same scientific-disciplinary sector directly awarded to the student can not be less than 50% of those already awarded)
- e) in the circumstance of a career made by a student who has already completed a degree at the University or in another Italian or foreign university and who requests, at the same time as enrolling, the abbreviation of studies
- f) in the circumstance to have supernumerary credits (compared to 180 under the law), acquired in the first level degree course (at the University or at another Italian or foreign university).

2 The Department Council, on the basis of the recognized credits, will decide on the possible shortening of the course.

3 It is not defined as a period of time validity of the credits acquired within the study courses. Credits acquired, in previous careers, by students who have lost their student status (for giving up on their studies or for not having taken exams for the number of consecutive years required for by the law in relation to the type of study course) can be validated with a specific resolution of the Department Council if the Department recognizes the non-obsolence of the related training contents.

Art. 17 - Next years' admission

In the circumstance of transfers, passages, acknowledgments (as regards art. 16), the enrollment for the second year of the course is allowed, subject to the examination of the ECTS / CFU received in the previous career by the Global Academic Board.

Art. 18 – Certifications

Language certifications are required exclusively for the purposes of admission to the master's degree course as illustrated in art. 6 paragraph 3 of this document.
